Creative Experiences Through Literature and Story Telling

Ages 3.5 to 6

Children love to learn about the world around them in very real yet creative ways. In this class children will gain the love of reading and story telling. They will also explore concepts such as, cultural experience, social skills or human virtues in each story through all five senses. Each class will begin with a children's book, story telling or poem. The children will explore that day's literary piece through music and movement, as well as a hands-on activity. This may include a science experiment, an art project or a cooking activity. Some classes may consist of a combination of science, art and cooking.

This class will be taught by Karen Nowak (primary teacher) and is for VMS students.
