



## *Fun with Spanish*



***“Create”, “plan”, and “operate” a fictitious restaurant***

***....en Español!***

- CREATE. Write a menu. Select theme/décor.
- PLAN. “Order” supplies. Write simple employee procedures. “Buy” the ingredients.
- OPERATE. Prepare an actual meal from the menu following basic commands.
- DINE. Practice conversational Spanish using role play to express preferences and use other “social” vocabulary to discuss family, weather and other familiar topics.

**VOCABULARY.** Creating and planning will reinforce and build on functional vocabulary such as food, numbers, colors, utensils, common objects etc. Writing the employee procedures will focus on basic commands.

**CONVERSATION.** Operating the restaurant will enhance listening and conversational skills.

**FUN.** The main objective of the course is to create a playful setting where students will have an opportunity to practice what they are learning in Spanish. The majority of each class will be dedicated to the interactive process of creating the restaurant. Each class will begin with a 15 minute vocabulary review and familiarization with verb tenses and conjugations. Supplemental vocabulary and grammar sheets will be provided.
