# Soccer Shots Waiver, Release and Refund Policy - Agreement to Participate in Soccer Shots

## WAIVER & RELEASE:

Participation in all sports can be inherently dangerous and, regardless of the care taken to avoid injury, it is impossible to ensure the safety of all participating individuals. The game of soccer is no exception. In fact, soccer has many inherent dangers. It is a sport that demands cardiovascular fitness, coordination, and agility. Players may spend more than 45 minutes in intense physical activity and heat and must be constantly aware of their surroundings (other players, goalposts, and the ball itself). Although soccer is not generally thought of as a contact sport, at competitive levels, it is. Although many risks can be avoided, some simply cannot.

While playing soccer, accidents do happen. Some of these accidents may be minor like collisions with other players, collisions with the ground, and being struck by the ball. Other accidents may be more significant like collisions with the goalposts. Other injuries may also include:

- minor injuries like scrapes, bruises, strains, blisters, and sprains;
- more serious injuries like broken bones, concussions, muscle tears, and ligament tears;
- catastrophic injuries like heat stroke, cardiac arrest, and death

To reduce the risk of injury, participants are expected to abide by the following rules:

- all participants are expected to be physically fit before Soccer Shots begins
- all players must adhere to the rules of soccer, thus creating a safe playing environment

The above-mentioned participant agrees to follow the preceding safety rules, all posted safety rules, and all rules common to the sport of soccer. Further, the above-mentioned participant agrees to report any unsafe practices, conditions, or equipment to the Soccer Shots instructor.

I certify that the above-mentioned participant

- 1) possesses a sufficient degree of physical fitness to safely participate in soccer,
- 2) understands that he/she is to discontinue activity at any time he/she feels undue discomfort or stress, and
- 3) has indicated in the "Special Needs" section any health-related conditions that might affect his/her ability to play soccer and he/she will verbally inform the Soccer Shots instructor immediately.

Please note any health related conditions that might affect the participant's ability to participate in Soccer Shots: Diabetes, Heart Problems, Seizures, Asthma, Other: \_\_\_\_\_.

I have read the preceding information and it has been explained to me. I know, understand, and appreciate the risks associated with participation in soccer and I am voluntarily participating the above-mentioned participant in the activity. In doing so, the above-mentioned participant is assuming all of the inherent risks of the sport. I further understand that in the event of a medical emergency, Soccer Shots or school/daycare staff will call EMS to render assistance and that I will be financially responsible for any expenses involved.

I do hereby consent and agree that Soccer Shots has the right to take photographs of my child and to use these on the company website ([www.soccershots.org](http://www.soccershots.org)) and promotional material without compensation. Your child's name and identity will not be revealed. If you would prefer we do not photograph your child please notify us via e-mail.

**Waiver of Liability:** In consideration of being permitted to play soccer, on behalf of myself, my family, my heirs, and my assigns, I hereby release Soccer Shots, Soccer Shots East Bay, its agents, and its employees from liability for injury, loss, or death to the above-mentioned participant while using any facility or equipment or in any way associated with participating in the activity of soccer now or in the future, resulting from the ordinary negligence of Soccer Shots, its agents and employees.

**Refunds, class cancellations, rain-outs and missed classes Policy:** Refunds will not be issued for non-attendance of a scheduled class. If a class needs to be rescheduled due to circumstances outside of our control, we do our best to schedule make-up classes when all students can attend, but we cannot guarantee this will always be the case. Whenever possible, we will use indoor space during inclement weather. If there is no indoor space available, there will be a maximum of two make-up weeks due to inclement weather (extreme cold, heat, or rain); there may be more than two weeks if scheduling permits, but it is not guaranteed. A 100% refund will be given with a written request up to 72 hours after the first class. A 100% refund less a \$15 admin fee will be given if a written request is received 48 hours prior to the second class. Refunds prior to the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> classes will be pro-rated less a \$15 admin fee. There are no refunds after the 4<sup>th</sup> class. All refund requests must be made via written request (email) and sent to [nic@soccershots.org](mailto:nic@soccershots.org). Should Soccer Shots find it necessary to de-register a child, a pro-rated refund will be issued less a \$15 admin fee.
